People Serving People is site of special visit by UCare Tooth Care

21 uninsured and underserved people to receive free dental care aboard “dentist’s office on wheels”

DETAILS: [UCare Tooth Care](#) is a fully equipped 37-foot Winnebago – a “dentist’s office on wheels” – that brings quality dental care to UCare members in Minnesota who have limited access to dental services.



[UCare](#) is partnering with People Serving People to address oral health disparities and raise awareness of the issue of dental access for the uninsured.

- This mobile dental unit will provide dental exams, cleanings, and fluoride treatments at no cost to 21 uninsured and underinsured people selected by People Serving People for this care.
- Participants will receive informative materials about the importance and techniques of good dental health. They also will be referred to a local community dental clinic for future care.
- Faculty and supervised dental and dental hygiene students from the University of Minnesota School of Dentistry staff the mobile dental unit and will deliver the dental care.
- UCare Tooth Care first rolled down Minnesota roads in August 2002 through a partnership between UCare and the University of Minnesota School of Dentistry. UCare is the first health plan in Minnesota to own and operate a mobile dental unit.
