

DTR DECISION TREE
FOR REPORTING SERVICES

This is the rank order in determining which type of service to use when reporting to DHS. The health plan may report multiple services to the client but will only report ONE service type per DTR to DHS.

Services should not be reported by major categories unless there are no subcategories.

The service subcategory “Other” should only be used when other subcategories do not apply.
