Note: UCare must receive all claims electronically no later than March 31, 2011.

<b>Breast Cancer Screening</b>	
<b>Who is eligible?</b>	To be eligible, members must be: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Female.</li> <li>• Medicare Advantage or MSHO members.</li> <li>• 52 to 69 years of age as of December 31, 2010.</li> <li>• Not up-to-date for breast cancer screening.</li> </ul> <i>Note: Age range is consistent with MN Community Measures specifications.</i>
<b>Continuous Enrollment</b>	Eleven-month continuous enrollment in both 2009 and 2010 and enrolled in December 2010.
<b>What qualifies for the year-end incentive?</b>	One mammogram in November or December 2010 for members who are not up-to-date. A member is up-to-date if she had a mammogram in 2009 or 2010.
<b>Specifications Source</b>	MMA, MCHP P4P Alignment Committee and consistent with MN Community Measures specifications, codes from HEDIS 2011.

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<b>Colorectal Cancer (CRC) Screening</b>	
<b>Who is eligible?</b>	To be eligible, members must be: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Medicare Advantage or MSHO members.</li> <li>• 50-75 years of age as of December 31, 2010.</li> <li>• Not up-to-date for CRC screening.</li> </ul>
<b>Continuous Enrollment</b>	Eleven-month continuous enrollment in both 2009 and 2010 and enrolled in December 2010.
<b>What qualifies for the year-end incentive?</b>	One screen for colorectal cancer in November or December 2010 for members who are not up-to-date.  Appropriate screenings are defined as: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Fecal occult blood test (FOBT)</b>—Member is up-to-date if they had an FOBT in 2010.</li> <li>• <b>Flexible sigmoidoscopy</b>—Member is up-to-date if they had a flexible sigmoidoscopy in 2010 or four years prior.</li> <li>• <b>Colonoscopy</b>—Member is up-to-date if they had a colonoscopy in 2010 or nine years prior.</li> </ul>

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<b>Diabetic Eye Exam and LDL-C Screening</b>	
<b>Who is eligible?</b>	To be eligible, members must be: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Medicare Advantage or MSHO members.</li> <li>• 18-75 years of age as of December 31, 2010.</li> <li>• Diagnosed with type 1 or type 2 diabetes as identified through pharmacy and claims data.</li> <li>• Not up-to-date for an annual retinal eye exam.</li> </ul>
<b>Continuous Enrollment</b>	Eleven-month continuous enrollment and enrolled in December 2010.
<b>What qualifies for the year-end incentive?</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• One retinal eye exam in November or December 2010 for members who are not up-to-date. A member is up-to-date if they had a retinal eye exam in 2010.</li> <li>• One LDL-C screen in November or December 2010 for members who are not up-to-date. A member is up-to-date if they had an LDL-C screen in 2010.</li> </ul>

\* Eye exams provided by eye care professionals are a proxy for dilated eye examinations because there is no administrative way to determine that a dilated exam was performed.

\*\* The organization does not need to limit CPT Category II codes or HCPCS S0625 to an optometrist or an ophthalmologist. These codes indicate an eye exam was performed by an eye care professional.

\*\*\*CPT Category II code 3072F can only be used if the claim/encounter was during the measurement year because it indicates the member had "no evidence of retinopathy in the prior year." Additionally, because the code definition itself indicates results were negative, an automated result is not required.
