Quick Reference Sheet: Claim Submission

A Part of the E3 Requirements: Eligibility, Claims, and Remittance

Minnesota law mandates the electronic transactions between all health care providers and group purchasers using a single, standard data content and format in 2009. This law standardizes and automates the processes for (1) verification of a patient’s eligibility and receiving a patient’s eligibility status, (2) submitting and adjudication of claims, and (3) generate and receiving remittance advices. This law is also known as **E3: Streamlining health care transactions in Minnesota**. This reference sheet will provide key information to providers as to how to submit electronic claims and attachments to UCare.

Electronic Claim Submissions

All claims are required to be submitted electronically by July 15, 2009, including institutional (837I), professional (837P), dental (837D), and pharmacy (NCPDP 5.1) claims. UCare works with several clearinghouses for the 837I and 837P claims to be submitted via EDI, as well as other electronic transactions. Electronic Claim Attachments

A claim attachment may be required to be submitted when either an 837I or an 837P is sent to UCare for adjudication. When an attachment to a claim is necessary, providers will need to populate the paperwork (PWK) segment in Loop 2300 of the electronic claim. The Administrative Uniformity Committee (AUC) Claim Attachment Cover Sheet must accompany with each attachment to ensure a proper match to the electronically submitted claim.

To submit a claim attachment after completing the AUC Claim Attachment Cover Sheet, fax the documents to UCare at **612-884-2261**. UCare will be following the submission guidelines as outlined in the AUC best practice for claims attachments.
