



# Skilled Nursing Facility 2010 Pharmacy Billing Fact Sheet

During a Part A stay, SNFs may bill separately for the following medications:

- **Abilify** (aripiprazole)
- **Anzemet** (dolasetron)
- **Aranesp** (darbepoetin alfa)
- **Cubicin** (daptomycin)
- **Copaxone** (glatiramer)
- **Epogen** (epoetin alfa)
- **Leukine** (sargramostim)
- **Lovenox** (enoxaparin sodium injection)
- **Kytril** (granisetron hydrochloride)
- **Maxaquin** (lomefloxacin hydrochloride tablets)
- **Neulast** (Pegfilgrastim)
- **Neupogen** (Filgrastim)
- **Procrit** (epoetin alfa)
- **Provigil** (modafinil)
- **Vancocin**
- **Vancomycin**
- **Zoladex** (goserelin)
- **Zofran** (ondansetron)
- **Zosyn** (Piperacillin and Tazobactam)

## Guidelines

- Each claim should be:
  - Submitted separately from room and board charges.
  - Submitted electronically with the pharmacy invoice attached.
- Attachments to a claim must include the Administrative Uniformity Committee (AUC) Cover Sheet and should be faxed to UCare at **612-884-2261**.
- REV Code: **0259**
- Bill Type: **021X** and **022X**
- CPT/HCPCS codes are not required. The inclusion of this coding will result in a claim denial.
- A description of the drug(s) must be submitted on your claim.
